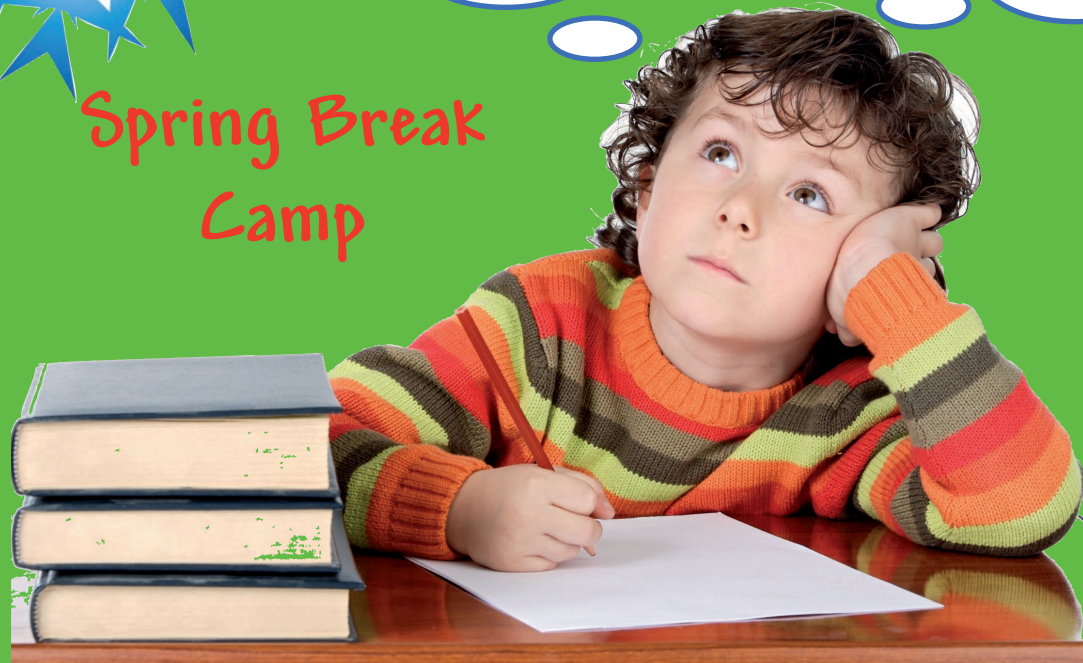

# Spring Break Camp (daily or all week long; preregistration required)

## Registrations

Friday, February 12th, from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m.  
Saturday, February 13th, from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Community Centre (1301 Rue du Bois)

You must bring your child's medicare card when you come to register him or her for camp activities.  
Fees are payable in cash or by cheque made to the Ville de Saint-Lazare.  
Please note that if registration is insufficient, we can cancel the day with prior notice.



## Non residents

The Service des loisirs has created a «Spring Break Camp» specially for their young residents. However, after the official registration period, we will accept non-residents if any places remain available.

## Daycare

The service des loisirs is offering parents a day-care service both before and after activities during the spring break week, that is, from 7 to 9 a.m., and from 4 to 6 p.m. The cost of one day-care period, either morning or afternoon, is \$5, and for both periods in the same day is \$7. Registration for day care should be made at the same time as official registration for the «Spring Break Camp», and fees are payable in cash or by cheque made to the Ville de Saint-Lazare.
