Here are your options:

The above instalment deadlines are valid for the tax account issued on February 17, 2012 and must be respected regardless of the date the new owner took over the ownership of the taxed property. All tax accounts that exceed \$300 may be acquitted in 3 instalments.

In person at the reception

Monday to Friday

from 8:30 a.m. to 12 p.m. and 1 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Accepted: debit, cash, cheque and postdated cheques



Outdoor mailbox

Deposit 24/7

Accepted: cheque and postdated cheques



By regular mail at Town Hall

Accepted: cheque and postdated cheques

Note: allow a reasonable time for Canada Post



By Internet

via your financial institution's online banking service. You must have subscribed to your financial institution's financial solutions

Recipient: Ville de Saint-Lazare*

* The way the Town's name is written may vary depending on your institution (for eg.: «st-lazare» or «saint-lazare» or «ville» or «municipalité»)

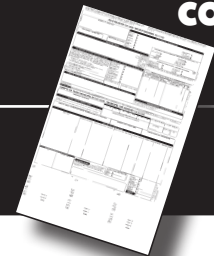

Late payments?

The Town will grant no further delay if you pay other than at the Town Hall's reception. To avoid interest charges, **your payment must be received by the Town** on the dates indicated on your tax return coupons. Late payments carry an **annual interest rate of 18 %** on the unpaid amount. **Only those who have missed a payment will receive a reminder.** However, those who subscribe to our website receive an email notice for each upcoming instalment deadline. **Subscribe at www.ville.saint-lazare.qc.ca/subscription.**
